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ORDER

On September 18, 2024 the Court conducted a hearing on Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Motion"). The Court considered the Motion papers, and GOOD CAUSE appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED as follows:

- 1. The Court preliminarily approves the Settlement memorialized in the Parties'

 Joint Stipulation of Class Action and PAGA Settlement and Release, attached as Exhibit 1 to

 Declaration of Sang (James) Park in support of Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class

 Action Settlement. The Court finds that the Settlement falls within the range of reasonableness
 of a settlement that could ultimately be granted final approval by the Court, and merits
 submission to Class Members for their consideration. All capitalized terms used in this Order
 shall have the same defined meanings as set forth in the Joint Stipulation of Class Action and
 PAGA Settlement and Release, unless stated otherwise.
- 2. The Court certifies the following Settlement Class for settlement purposes only pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure § 382:

All current and former non-exempt employees, including temporary employees contracted through any and all agencies, who have worked for Defendants in California during the time period of July 21, 2019 through the date of Preliminary Approval

- 3. The Court approves the Notice of Class Action Settlement ("Class Notice"), attached as Exhibit A to Settlement Agreement, for mailing to Class Members.
 - 4. The Court appoints Sang (James) Park of PARK APC as Class Counsel.
 - 5. The Court appoints Abigail Johnson as the Class Representative.
 - 6. The Court appoints Atticus Administration, LLC as the Claims Administrator.
- 7. The Court preliminarily approves Class Counsel's request for Attorney's Fees and Costs subject to final review by the Court.
- 8. The Court preliminarily approves Class Counsel's request for Plaintiff's Service Payment subject to final review by the Court.

9. The Court preliminarily approves the Claims Administration Fee to be paid to Atticus Administration, LLC.

- 10. The Court preliminarily approves the PAGA Payment pursuant to Private Attorneys General Act.
 - 11. The following dates shall govern for the purposes of the Settlement:

Deadline	Activity
21 days from Preliminary Approval	Defendants shall provide Claims Administrator with the Class Data List.
35 days from Preliminary Approval	Claims Administrator shall mail, by U.S. First Class, to Class Members a Class Notice. The Class Notice shall list the individual Settlement Class Member's total number of Workweeks.
60 days from mailing date	All Class Members' requests for exclusion, and objections must be postmarked by this date.
30 days from completion of the notice period	Plaintiff shall submit their Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees and Costs and Class Representative's Enhancement Payment.
16 court days from Plaintiff's filing Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees and Costs and Class Representative's Enhancement Payment	The Court will hear Plaintiff's Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees and Costs and Class Representative's Enhancement Payment.

12. Class Members are enjoined from initiating or prosecuting any proceeding on any claim to be released pursuant to the Stipulation unless and until the Class Member opts out of the Class.

- 13. Class Counsel shall file their Motion for Final Approval of Class Action
 Settlement and Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees and Costs and Class Representative's
 Enhancement Payment by thirty days from completion of the notice period.
- 14. On February 12, 2025 at 9 am, the Court will hold a final fairness hearing to determine whether the Settlement, including Class Counsel's attorney's fees and costs and Class Representative's Enhancement Award, should be finally approved as fair, reasonable and adequate.
